







DECLARE CASH* OF €10,000 OR MORE

that you are carrying on your own behalf or for a third party as part of an intra- or extra-EU transfer

If you are carrying €50,000 or more, you will have to present proof of origin of the funds

*banknotes, negotiable instruments that are in bearer form (cheques, travellers' cheques, promissory notes, money orders, etc.), gold



DECLARE THE GOODS

that you are carrying (purchased or received as a gift) and



TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE ALLOWANCES

Value-based allowances/person

Arriving from mainland France & the EU:

• €1,000 (with no age restrictions)

Arriving from a non-EU country:

- € 430 (traveller aged 15 or over)
- €150 (traveller aged under 15)

Volume-based allowances/person aged 17 or over

- 200 cigarettes or
- 100 cigarillos or
- 50 cigars or
- 250g (330,69 lb) of smoking tobacco
- proportional combinations

- 16 litres of beer (+)
- 4 litres of still non-sparkling wine (+)
- 2 litres of beverages with ABV ≤ of 22% or



- 1 litre of beverages with ABV of over 22% or
- proportional combinations



OVER AND ABOVE THESE ALLOWANCE LIMITS, PAY



- → Taxes on goods purchased or offered, regardless of where you are arriving from
- → Customs duties, only if you are arriving from a non-EU country

COMPLY WITH SPECIFIC PROVISIONS

aimed at safeguarding health, safety, the environment and heritage

The following are restricted

presentation of supporting documents and compliance with volume thresholds























The following are totally banned





- Animals & plants* protected under the Washington Convention**
- Cultural goods
 Weapons & ammunition
 Pharmaceuticals
- Foodstuffs & certain products with animal origin***
- Pets
 Plants & plant products (fresh fruit, flowers)

*and their parts and products (hides, feathers, teeth, etc.) ***from non-EU countries only (honey, fish, etc.)

**CITES appendices

- DrugsCounterfeits
- Aniseed-based spirits
- Meat, milk & products in containers

*IAS: Invasive alien species (plants or animals)
